Barolo Riserva Cannubi Collezione Rag. Franco Miroglio is Tenuta Carretta's "iconic" label. An important wine, created to celebrate both the company's winemaking tradition and a great man, Franco Miroglio: a visionary entrepreneur and the creator of the family's success in the fields of manufacturing and fashion. It was he who acquired Tenuta Carretta in 1985 and so began the family's winemaking history. Dedicating a great wine, as elegant and important as this Barolo Riserva, to him was a way to honour his memory.

A special bottle, produced from our own Nebbiolo vineyards on the Cannubi hill, in one the most prestigious Additional Geographical References in the entire appellation. A bottle to collect as well as drink, which from year to year is "dressed" with a unique label featuring a pattern from a Miroglio-designed fabric- each vintage displays a different pattern that has been a success for the company.

With production limited to just 1,260 bottles each vintage, it is a Barolo of great complexity and structure which ages for over 60 months, of which at least 36 in barrels and 18 in the bottle.

In the glass it is a deep, garnet red, while on the nose the full, complex bouquet blends rose, undergrowth, spices, chocolate and coffee with a subtle citrus note. Dense, silky tannins give the wine body and harmony.
